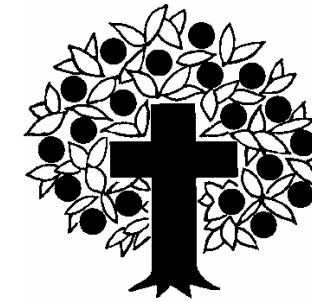

Just as a song or poem can express feelings of fear, doubt, hope, and joy, these 15 psalms model how study participants can voice their own petitions and praises to our God, who is always available and ready to hear us. After the funeral when friends and family have gone home, when the cards and telephone calls stop coming, and when everyone else has resumed a normal life, the real work of grief recovery begins. GriefShare is a weekly seminar and support group designed to help provide the ongoing support and encouragement needed to heal from the hurt of the loss of a loved one. Each of the 13 weekly sessions includes viewing a 35 minute DVD produced in television magazine format which features top experts on topics of grief. The sessions also include an opportunity for each participant to talk about their own grief experience and hear from others with similar experiences while in the support group discussions. GriefShare will help you in your journey from mourning to joy. **Begins May 6.**
